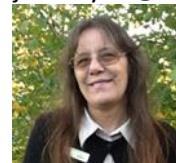

Being digitally aware allows us to fulfil these obligations...

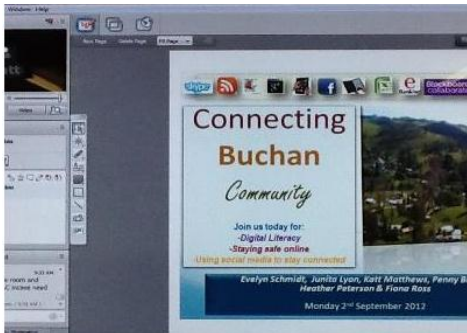
What is a Webinar?
